	use their facilities.
Sunday 22 nd	Pray for many visitors to hear the gospel at St Luke's Nativity

Monday	Pray for those in our church families who are housebound, or
23 rd	whose family live far away, or who don't have family, that they
	would not be alone this Christmas, but that church family would

	patient endurance in their suffering and relief from it.
Sunday 29th	Pray that as we meet at St Luke's and St Andrew's this morning
	that God would speak to each one of us as we have need.
Monday	Give thanks for the partnership in the gospel that we have
30 th	shared in 2024 with likeminded churches in the Hull Ministry
	Association and West Hull Prayer networks: All Saints North
	Ferriby, St Peter's Anlaby, St Mark's Anlaby Common, St
	Martin's Hull, St Thomas's and Church of the Ascension Hull,

	Southcoates, St John's Bransholme and Kingston Evangelical
	Church. Pray that God would bless each one in 2025 and bring
